Dr. Porter is Professor of Medicine and Director of Allogeneic Stem Cell Transplantation and Immunotherapy at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia, PA. After receiving his medical degree from Brown University, Dr. Porter completed an internship and a residency at University Hospital in Boston. He then completed clinical and research fellowships in hematology/oncology at Harvard Medical School and Brigham & Women's Hospital, also in Boston.

He is a member of the American Society of Hematology, the American Society of Clinical Oncology, and the American Society of Blood and Marrow Transplantation. In 2007, Dr. Porter was awarded *The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society's* Service to Mankind Award, which is bestowed for "dedicated service to the highest standards of the medical profession, his humanistic approach to patient care and his tireless efforts in researching cures for blood cancers."

He has authored more than 100 research articles, abstracts and book chapters, is an associate editor for the *American Journal of Hematology* and has served as a manuscript reviewer for numerous medical journals, including *Annals of Internal Medicine* and *The New England Journal of Medicine*.
