After earning a medical degree from McGill University in Montreal, Canada, Dr. Luger completed her residency in internal medicine at the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center Presbyterian Hospital and her fellowship in hematology/oncology at the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine.

She is a member of several professional societies, including the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, the American Society of Hematology, the American Society of Clinical Oncology and the Eastern Cooperative Oncology Group. She has been recognized by *The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society* as Woman of the Year, and also honored by them with the Journey to a Cure Award. In addition, Dr. Luger received a National Research Service Award from the National Institutes of Health, and the McCabe Foundation Pilot Project Grant.

Her research interests include leukemia and myelodysplastic syndromes. She has participated in several clinical trials and coauthored numerous articles and abstracts. She has been invited to lecture throughout the country and has chaired several national meetings on the subjects of leukemia, myelodysplastic syndromes and stem cell transplantation.
